



Satellite Broadband – Phase 2

The Opportunity

Phase 2 builds upon the foundation of Phase 1, scaling the satellite broadband infrastructure to provide cross-border connectivity throughout the Gulf region and deeper coverage in Syria. The project focuses on integrating hybrid satellite-fiber infrastructure, including gateway ground stations and advanced customer terminals.

Market Demand

- Expands access to 30M+ underserved users across MENA
- Government and private sector contracts for secure broadband
- Enhanced disaster recovery and emergency network resilience
- Strategic for education, commerce, remote work, and e-governance

Investment Snapshot

- Capital Requirement: \$12–15 million
- Gateway Infrastructure: 4–6 hubs across 3 countries
- Revenue Potential: \$60M cumulative over 5 years
- Break-even: Year 3–4 with stable multi-year service contracts

- Positions SIG International as a regional broadband backbone
- Complements smart grid, fintech, and e-learning ecosystems
- Prepares platform for LEO/MEO satellite service expansion
