



Syringe Production Facility – Syria

The Opportunity

Syringes are essential to all vaccination, treatment, and diagnostic protocols. Yet, local production in Syria is minimal. This project establishes a modern syringe manufacturing facility to meet national demand and supply regional markets, including auto-disable, insulin, and standard-use syringes.

Market Demand

- Over 50M syringes needed annually in Syria
- Sharp increase in demand post-pandemic
- Regional demand from Iraq, Lebanon, Libya
- Growing need for auto-disable and safety syringes

Investment Snapshot

- Capital Requirement: \$8–12 million
- Production Capacity: 100M units/year
- Product Lines: 1ml, 3ml, insulin, auto-disable syringes
- Breakeven: Year 3

Competitive Advantage

- WHO/UNICEF procurement alignment
- Lower logistics and customs cost vs. imports
- Local contracts with hospitals and NGOs
- Export potential with health ministries and aid agencies

- Ensures reliable access to safe injection tools
- Supports national immunization and diabetes programs
